




Inelastic Supply



A small change in quantity can result in a large change in price. A small drop in demand, can result in a large price drop.



- Exports represent only 30% of all recycled materials
- China was half of that or 15% of all recycled materials
- Remaining 70% recycled domestically



Small Change in **Demand** Leads to Large Price Impact.


