

E-Waste

Arkansas has created a first-in-the-nation recovery program for old electronics called e-waste. The e-waste recycling program will begin on January 1, 2023. The new program will put in motion a statewide plan to recover over 8,000 tons of e-waste annually. Leading the way will be Arkansas state government, including offices in all 15 departments, colleges and universities, public school districts, commissions, and boards. 
